E - 14 Market Steer, born after January 1 previous year and weighing a minimum of 1,050 lbs. and maximum payable weight of 1,400 lbs. Steers will be divided into market class according to weight (light to heavy weight). All entries will be entered into the Market Steer Carcass Contest.

E -15 Feeder Market Steer (steers weighing less than 1050 lbs. that were entered in class E-14)

16-() Beef Showmanship Note: you must show in showmanship to sell a market animal

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Class E--Senior, Just completed grade 10, 11, or 12

Class F--Adult, Out of high school not a recent graduate

Class G--Professional

**** Market Steer Carcass Contest**, animals must be cross entered in **E-14**, make weight at fair and sell to be slaughtered by resale buyer (Tyson) or Baker City butcher that will butcher in time for grading to be made. Animals taken home by buyer or butchered elsewhere will not be eligible because of practicalities related to grading. Placing is determined with criteria established by the Oregon Carcass Steer of Merit Program as revised March 2009. If data results in a tie, Livestock Superintendent will be responsible for forming a committee of three local knowledgeable individuals to resolve tie. The committee's decision will be final. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes to be awarded.
