EXHIBIT BOOTHS GUIDELINES AND RULES

- 1) Requests for booth space must be made by August 1st. Please contact the division superintendent. Booths are numbered 1 through 6 beginning at the west end of the exhibit hall. Booths are assigned on a “first come first served” basis. Booth positions will be assigned according to a blind drawing.
- 2) Though not a rule, it is suggested entrants us the theme “Dust Off Your Hats, Shine Your Boots, And Celebrate 2010!”
- 3) Competition booths must not be used as a method for distributing handouts, brochures, or pamphlets for commercial purposes.
- 4) Booths not reserved for competition premium points will be filled at the discretion of the Fair Manager.
- 5) There are six booths, each of which is 8’ wide by 6’ deep.

Booth Scorecard:

- 1) Exhibits in this lot should tell an important story on marketable crops, specialty crops, industry or community living within Baker County. Basis for scoring:
 - Representative of County;..25pts.
 - Effectiveness of Display;....30pts. (e.g. center of interest, simplicity, balance, color etc.)
 - Quality of Products:20pts.
 - Originality;.....25pts.
 - Perfect Score.....100pts
